About South Clyde Energy Centre

Welcome to the E-newsletter for the South Clyde Energy Centre. We will publish these newsletters regularly to provide consistent and up to date information on the project.

The South Clyde Energy Centre is an Energy from Waste facility currently under construction on land at Bogmoor Road, North Cardonald, Glasgow.

The centre will recover energy by processing around 350,000 tonnes of residual and commercial waste every year. The waste will be first sorted to remove the recyclable material, and the remaining waste, which would otherwise be sent to landfill or exported, will then be treated at the facility. Through the energy recovery process, the centre will generate up to 45Mwe (megawatts electricity) of energy, enough to power the equivalent of around 70,000 homes.

Construction Update

Work on site is moving forward well, with several key areas now completed or close to completion:

- The main bunker steel structure is now finished.
- Work has focused on the electrical switch room and the admin building, including external walls and windows.
- The main electrical systems are being installed, with connection to the grid planned this summer.
- The boiler building is nearly complete. Internal lining work has been finished, scaffolding has been removed, and electrical work is continuing.
- In the tipping hall, most of the structure is in place, with just two sections left before external cladding begins.
- Mechanical systems are close to being ready for testing. Most pipework checks have been completed, and power systems are expected to start being switched on in June or July.

Traffic and Route Planning

As part of the planning permission for the South Clyde Energy Centre, a route management plan has been developed to help reduce the impact of traffic and waste deliveries on local communities around the facility. The plan outlines the following:

- Vehicles will mainly use the M8 and avoid residential areas.
- Routes near the Queen Elizabeth Hospital and along Shieldhall Road are to be avoided wherever possible.
- All suppliers will be required to follow these routes.
- Checks will be carried out to ensure suppliers are following the route management plan.

This plan has been submitted to Glasgow City Council and once approved, will be shared with all suppliers to ensure compliance.
